### **Individualized, Custom Treatment Plans** – We support each client's unique needs and desires and embrace all avenues of sustained recovery from drug and alcohol addiction.

Medically Assisted Treatment (MAT) - Direct partnership with community resources to enable clients access to MAT providers.

**Case Management** –Our clients are assigned a case manager to assist in connecting them with needed community resources while in treatment and beyond.

**Mental Health and PCP Referral** – We refer clients to the best medical providers in the community to address co-occurring mental or physical health concerns.

**Individual and Group Counseling** – Provided on-site to address symptoms of substance use disorders and deliver peer support, encouragement, and education.



**Life Skills** – We encourage our clients to learn the basics of cooking, housekeeping, and financial management. Safe Harbor also aids with educational attainment (GED/ diploma), resume building, and job interview preparation.



### **Health & Wellness**

We provide healthy meals and snacks that are freshly prepared on-site.

Our bedrooms are spacious – no bunk beds or dorm-style living arrangements.

The SHR facility has ample indoor and outdoor recreation space to promote physical, as well as mental, wellness and unity.



Safe Harbor Recovery keeps clients engaged in recovery throughout the entire continuum of residential, outpatient, recovery housing, and their transition to independent living. Our high and low-intensity residential treatment program allows our clients to build a strong foundation for recovery while they work and attend meetings in the community.

Our program is designed to break relapse behavior patterns of addiction and address triggers through:

**Continuing Care** – SHR focuses on our clients' continued success in long term recovery by offering in-house IOP, after-care and a direct referral to safe sober living options within the community.

**Peer Support** – We engage a broad community in promoting the recovery, self-determination, self-advocacy, well-being, and independence of our clients.
